

Juvenile Idiopathic Arthritis Patient Referral for
Medicines for Children Research Network
adopted Clinical Trial

Have you seen a child in clinic who meets the following criteria?

- ✓ Is between 2 - 17 years of age
- ✓ Has documented evidence of polyarticular-course juvenile idiopathic arthritis (pcJIA) diagnosis at least 6 months ago
- ✓ Has at least 5 joints with active arthritis, with at least 3 of those joints having limitation of motion
- ✓ Is not currently taking or taking a stable dose of methotrexate, oral corticosteroids, or NSAIDS
- ✓ Has no current uveitis
- ✓ Has either discontinued treatment with a biologic or is biologic naive
- ✓ Has no other autoimmune, rheumatic disease or overlap syndrome other than pcJIA
- ✓ Is not wheelchair bound or bedridden

If so, they could be eligible for recruitment into a clinical trial.
